READ TOGETHER

Hebrews 11:8–10

1. Have you ever had to move?
 - a. If yes, how did you feel when you were packing, moving and settling into your new home?
 - b. If no, what comes to mind when you think about moving? Does it make you excited or nervous?

2. Have you or anyone you know had to obey God without knowing how it would turn out?

LIVE IT

Moving takes a lot of time, effort and it can be tough emotionally, leaving friends and family behind. But imagine if you were told to move, not knowing where you were going!

God told Abraham to move several times, but Abraham didn't just trust God by moving. He also had to believe that God would show him where to go, where to stop, when to rest, when to move again, and where he should plant his family. Abraham even had to trust that God would give him a family one day because he was an old man without any kids. Abraham had to trust that God would keep His promise, even when it took years, and seemed impossible. Yet God kept every single promise He made to Abraham. God is faithful, and He will keep every single promise He makes to you too.

LEAN ON GOD

Dear God,

Thank You for being trustworthy. If You make a promise, You keep it. It may not always turn out the way we think or even the way we want, but remind us that You know what You're doing and Your way is better than we could ever imagine.
