

Family Talk–Invitation

READ TOGETHER

Exodus 3:7-10

1. Why do you think God used Moses to help the Israelites?
2. How is God inviting you to help the people around you who are suffering?

LIVE IT

Sometimes when we're going through a hard time, we might wonder if God even cares, but in these verses we see that God sees the suffering of His people. He cared about the terrible things the Egyptians were doing to the Israelites, and He cares about the suffering in the world around us today. God will do something in His time.

God loves to use ordinary people to do extraordinary things. Moses couldn't help the Israelites on his own, but with God anything is possible, and the Israelites were freed. Think about the hurt that's happening to people in your life. There may be a kid at school who doesn't get to eat three meals a day, or someone on your sports team who only has one set of clothes to wear. Are you seeing these things? How may God be inviting you to help in the world around you?
